As previous author, services offered by UJPR to authors crown their efforts and accentuate their work path, a sever peer-review system and both the reviewers and author remain anonymous throughout the process. Researchers preferred only a rapid journal, and cited indexed journals in Scopus and publish their articles in non-indexed journals; led some Editors to demand citing publications from previous issues to enhance merits of journal, mostly, with time authors will trust to journals according to other criteria.

Researchers should deal with some laws, but fall into the trap of predatory reviews with attractive website, supposedly indexed in Scopus, all this torture distorts the art of research, and its main goal of interchange of information, as delaying its application in industries or hospitals.



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
