UJPR as a scientific journal required a technical language facilitating its readability to reviewers who asked to focus only on scientific side of the paper.

Reviewers have given sufficient time in case they accept to review the paper, as expected reviewers with their constructive feedback attempt to improve the presentation of the article.

Publications in this journal have licensed under Creative Commons Attribution-Non-Commercial 4.0 international and authors should grant that the first publication of their works would be in UJPR. Greater opportunities of citation of the article, embodiment and development of the work obtained by dint of 'Open Access'. As UJPR aim to interchange scientific knowledge and productive exchange, that, established in high read articles treating subjects as: entomotherapy, immunotherapy, pharmacotherapy, phytotherapy, indicating the wide fields treated during the previous issues.
